ABOUT THE BARN TOUR

The **DeKalb County Barn Tour** is a one-day driving tour on **August 13, 2016, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.**

The event is jointly hosted by the Joseph F. Glidden Homestead & Historical Center (GH) and the DeKalb Area Agricultural Heritage Association (DAAHA). Tickets are \$25 per vehicle (buses extra). Members of the JF Glidden Homestead or DAAHA receive a \$5 discount.

Participants receive a map and Guide Book containing hand-drawn sketches of each barn and the story of each barn's history, style, and use. Drive to each location, in any order, to view & learn about the barn(s). Be aware that this is an outdoor activity that may involve walking on uneven ground.
